Other

Initial assessment screen with a brief summary: £160 – £220

What this includes:

- A pre-assessment questionnaire (completed by you)
- 60-minutes of assessment time (£160) or 90 minutes of assessment time (£220).
- The assessment will contain one or more of the following: completing a case history, formal assessment, informal assessment, observation, questionnaires, conversations with you, your child or other professionals, feedback from activities completed, discussions about the next steps.
- You will receive a short, written summary via email with an outline of activities completed and recommendations. Please note recommendations may include further assessment or liaison time.

This package may be suitable for you if:

- You are not sure if your child needs speech and language therapy.
- You do not need a written report.
- Your child is not likely to need a lot of support. For example, their speech is generally clear but they have difficulties saying the "r" sound.
- Children who have recently had a detailed speech and language therapy assessment and have a written report with targets and recommendations.
- You would like allocated time to chat to the therapist (the 30-minutes discussion time is recommended for this).

Initial assessment screen with a written report: £240 - £280

What this includes:

- A pre-assessment questionnaire (completed by you)
- 60-minutes of assessment time (£240) or 90-minutes of assessment time (£280).
- The assessment will contain one or more of the following: completing a case history, formal assessment, informal assessment, observation, questionnaires, conversations with you, your child or other professionals, feedback from activities completed, discussions about the next steps.
- You will receive a written report via email (90-minutes report writing and analysis time is included) detailing findings from the assessment, recommendations and if appropriate, suggested areas to work on.
- Reports are usually sent out within 14 days after the assessment.

This package may be suitable for you if:

- You have concerns about your child's speech, language, and communication skills.
- You would like to share information with others such as your child's school.
- You would like allocated time to chat to the therapist (the 90-minute assessment time is recommended for this).
- Your child has difficulty in one area e.g., their speech is difficult to understand but there are no other concerns with their talking or communication.

2-hour assessment with a written report: £540

What this includes:

- A pre-assessment questionnaire (completed by you)
- 120-minutes of assessment time (to be completed over two sessions).
- 60-meetings of meeting time (time can be used flexibly e.g., 30-minutes with parents, 30-minutes with school staff or 60-minutes with parents).
- The assessment will contain one or more of the following: completing a case history, formal assessment, informal assessment, observation, questionnaires, us with you, your child or other professionals, feedback from activities completed, discussions about the next steps.
- You will receive a written report via email (180-minutes report writing and analysis time is included) detailing findings from the assessment, recommendations and if appropriate, targets and areas to work on.
- Reports are usually sent out within 14 days after the last assessment date.

This package may be suitable for you if:

- Your child has difficulties in more than one area e.g., they have difficulties expressing what they want to say and understanding what others say to them.
- Your child is school-aged (over 5 years old).
- You would like to share information with your child's school and other relevant professionals.
- You would like allocated time for meeting with the therapist (and for the therapist to meet with school staff).

4-hour assessment with a detailed written report: £900

- A pre-assessment questionnaire (completed by you)
- 240-minutes of assessment time (to be completed over four sessions and to include at least one observation).
- 60-minutes of meeting time (time can be used flexibly e.g., 30-minutes with parents, 30-minutes with school staff or 60-minutes with parents).
- The assessment will contain one or more of the following: completing a case history, formal assessment, informal assessment, observation, questionnaires, conversations with you, your child or other professionals, feedback from activities completed, discussions about the next steps.
- You will receive a detailed written report via email (240-minutes report writing and analysis time is included) with findings from the assessment, recommendations and if appropriate, targets and areas to work on.
- Reports are usually sent out within 14 days after the last assessment date.

This package may be suitable for you if:

- You would like a full assessment of your child's speech, language, and communication profile.
- You are worried about your child and you would like to know if there are any underlying language difficulties that could be affecting their academic progress, behaviour, self-esteem or confidence.
- You are considering applying for an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP).
- You think your child may have Developmental Language Disorder.
- You would like clear information about what your child needs for the next 12-months.

A review session with a brief summary: £140 - £190

What this includes:

- 60-minutes of assessment time (£140) or 90-minutes of assessment time (£190).
- The assessment will contain one or more of the following: formal assessment, informal assessment, observation, questionnaires, conversations with you, your child or other professionals, feedback from activities completed, discussions about the next steps.
- You will receive a short, written summary via email with an outline of activities completed and recommendations.

This package may be suitable for you if:

- You are already known to That Speech Lady and your child has been seen for an assessment or therapy sessions.
- You would like to know if further sessions or support is required.
- You would like allocated time to chat to the therapist (the 90-minute assessment time is recommended for this).
- You do not need a written report.

A review session with a written report: £220 - £260

What this includes:

- 60-minutes of assessment time (£220) or 90-minutes of assessment time (£260).
- The assessment will contain one or more of the following: formal assessment, informal assessment, observation, questionnaires, conversations with you, your child or other professionals, feedback from activities completed, discussions about the next steps.
- You will receive a written report via email (90-minutes report writing and analysis time is included) detailing findings from the assessment, recommendations and if appropriate, suggested areas to work on.
- Reports are usually sent out within 14 days after the assessment.

This package may be suitable for you if:

- You have concerns about your child's speech, language, and communication skills.
- You would like to share information with others such as your child's school.
- You would like allocated time to chat to the therapist (the 90-minute assessment time is recommended for this).
- Your child has difficulty in one area e.g., their speech is difficult to understand but there are no other concerns with their talking or communication.

Therapy sessions: £75 or £100 per session

What this includes:

- After an assessment or review session, we may agree to start therapy sessions. The number of sessions will be discussed and agreed with you.
- A therapy session lasts for 45-minutes (£75) or 60-minutes (£100) and involves working on agreed aims and targets. This time includes working on activities and discussions with you.
- Therapy sessions may require attendance and participation from a parent, family or staff member. This will help your child make maximum progress and generalise learnt skills.

Therapy sessions may be suitable for you if:

- You are already known to That Speech Lady and your child has been seen for an assessment or review session.
- You would like to learn how to support your child's speech and language skills.
- You would a high level of support, either for a short period of time or longer.
- Please note: for stammering therapy, or therapy working on more than one area of difficulty, 60-minute sessions are usually recommended.

A written programme with targets, activity ideas and resources: £100

- After an assessment or a review session, we may recommend a written programme is created. A programme will usually include targets, activity ideas and resources specifically tailored to what your child needs.
- It is often recommended programmes are worked on at home and in your child's educational setting.

A written programme may be suitable for you if:

- You would like activities to do at home (and if relevant, to share with school staff too).
- You are not looking for a high level of support.
- You or your child's school have a trained member of staff who has knowledge, confidence, and experience in delivering speech and language programmes.

Demonstration sessions: £75 or £100 per session

- Some programmes may require a demonstration so educational staff or parents can fully understand how to deliver and present activities.
- The demonstration session requires your child to be present and the family or staff member who will be working with your child.
- A demonstration session lasts for 45-minutes (£75) or 60-minutes (£100).

Demonstration sessions may be suitable for you if:

- You are already known to That Speech Lady and your child has been seen for an assessment or review session.
- You would like to support your child's speech and language skills.
- You would like to be shown how to use the resources provided and work on targets.
- You would like a written programme but you do not yet feel confident delivering this on your own.

Meetings: £75 (45-minutes) or £100 (£60-minutes)

- That Speech Lady is available to attend meetings with you and other professionals working with your child.
- We can discuss our involvement with your child and any reports or programmes we have written. We can also discuss the impact of your child's speech, language and communication difficulties.
- The duration of the meeting must be agreed in advance.
